The organization

CERGAS was established in 1978 to promote scientific research on healthcare management at national and international level. Nowadays, while keeping its focus on management of healthcare organizations, it is a multidisciplinary research center that investigates a vast array of issues and topics concerning healthcare management, health policy, health economics and not-for-profit organizations. CERGAS carries out research projects on topical issues in healthcare management, health policy, health economics and not-for-profit and disseminates them through publications in major scientific journals. CERGAS' research projects are funded by a plurality of institutions, including European Commission, Private Foundations, Italian Ministry of Health, Regional Health Authorities, WHO, Public and private health care providers and Pharmaceutical and biomedical companies.

In the last twenty years, CERGAS has heavily invested in the area of health policy, focusing on the definition and management of these policies and their related impact assessment. Specifically, current projects focus on policies relating to the health technology sectors.

Description of the position and requirements

We are seeking an enthusiastic Researcher to join our Centre and work on a variety of projects in the area of Health Policy, such as pharmaceutical observatory (observatory on the pharmaceutical market, on the relative regulation policies and on the effects of these policies), analysis of regional and local policies on biosimilar drugs, patients' therapeutic pathways and evaluation of their preferences (Discrete choice experiment) and MEA (Managed Entry Agreements) Lab (if approved).

The main activities in which the researcher will be involved are:

- a. Analysis of data on consumption and expenditure on drugs (trend analysis, support for forecast analysis, report drafting)
- b. Collection of comparative data on regional policies relating to pharmaceutical care (document analysis, comparative classification of policies)



- c. Support for the administration and management of data relating to surveys envisaged in research projects
- d. Support to papers' drafting

The requirements for applying to this position are:

1. Maximum age: 35 years' old
2. MSc in Economics, Political Science, Biomedical Engineering, Statistics, Pharmacy, Chemistry and pharmaceutical technologies, Biotechnology, Medicine
3. Post bachelor Diploma (mandatory for Bachelor's degree) or post graduated Master degree (preferential in case of MSc degree) in healthcare economics/policy/management or pharmaceutical regulatory affairs
4. PhD and/or 2 years working experience in the pharmaceutical industry (preferential)
5. Knowledge of the Italian and main European healthcare systems
6. Knowledge of the Italian and European pharmaceutical regulatory affairs
7. Strong knowledge of Microsoft Office (Excel, word, power point)
8. Good statistical skills and good knowledge of the statistical software (i.e. Stata)
9. Knowledge of the Italian (mother tongue) and English languages (B2 level)
10. Strong analytical and synthesis skills and team working oriented

The position is for 1 year (renewable), does not include mandatory teaching activity and will be remunerated according to a competitive salary in the range of € 35.000-40.000 per annum according to experience and CV. Cergas is in Bocconi, Via Rontgen 1, Milano.
