#### The organization

CERGAS was established in 1978 to promote scientific research on healthcare management at national and international level. Nowadays, while keeping its focus on management of healthcare organizations, it is a multidisciplinary research center that investigates a vast array of issues and topics concerning healthcare management, health policy, health economics and not-for-profit organizations. CERGAS carries out research projects on topical issues in healthcare management, health policy, health economics and not-for-profit and disseminates them through publications in major scientific journals. CERGAS' research projects are funded by a plurality of institutions, including European Commission, Private Foundations, Italian Ministry of Health, Regional Health Authorities, WHO, Public and private health care providers and Pharmaceutical and biomedical companies. In the last twenty years, CERGAS has heavily invested in the area of health economics, health technology assessment (HTA) and economic evaluation analysis aimed at comparing and assessing alternative healthcare programmes and technologies to support the health-related decision making process as to allocation of scarce resources. Within this research area, CERGAS undertakes a range of methodological and applied research in health economics with particular attention on economic evaluation of healthcare technologies/programs and their use in policy making. HE & HTA areas conduct economic and statistical analyses using data from randomized controlled trials, decision analytic modelling studies, observational and retrospective (administrative) data sets.

#### Description of the position and requirements

We are seeking an enthusiastic Research Fellow to join CERGAS to work on health economics, with a focus on the empirical analysis of administrative and observational data. The successful candidate will be involved in variety of projects in the area of health economics, with a focus on the empirical analysis of administrative and observational data. The post holder will be expected to undertake systematic literature reviews, perform statistical and econometric data analyses and disseminate results. In addition, s/he may be involved in the management and data collection for new and ongoing projects.

Applicants should have a PhD in health economics or related areas (e.g. public health, epidemiology, social sciences with a focus on health and healthcare) and a solid background in



quantitative research methods. Proficiency in English and experience with econometric software packages (Stata or R) are prerequisites for the position.

In addition, candidates should have:

- Successful track record of scientific publications.
- Team-work orientation and problem solving attitude.
- Good communication and writing skills.

### Appointments and Salary

The successful candidate is expected to start by September 2<sup>nd</sup> 2019. The position is for 1 year (renewable) and will be remunerated according with a competitive salary in the range of € 35.000- 40.000 per annum according to experience and publication record.
